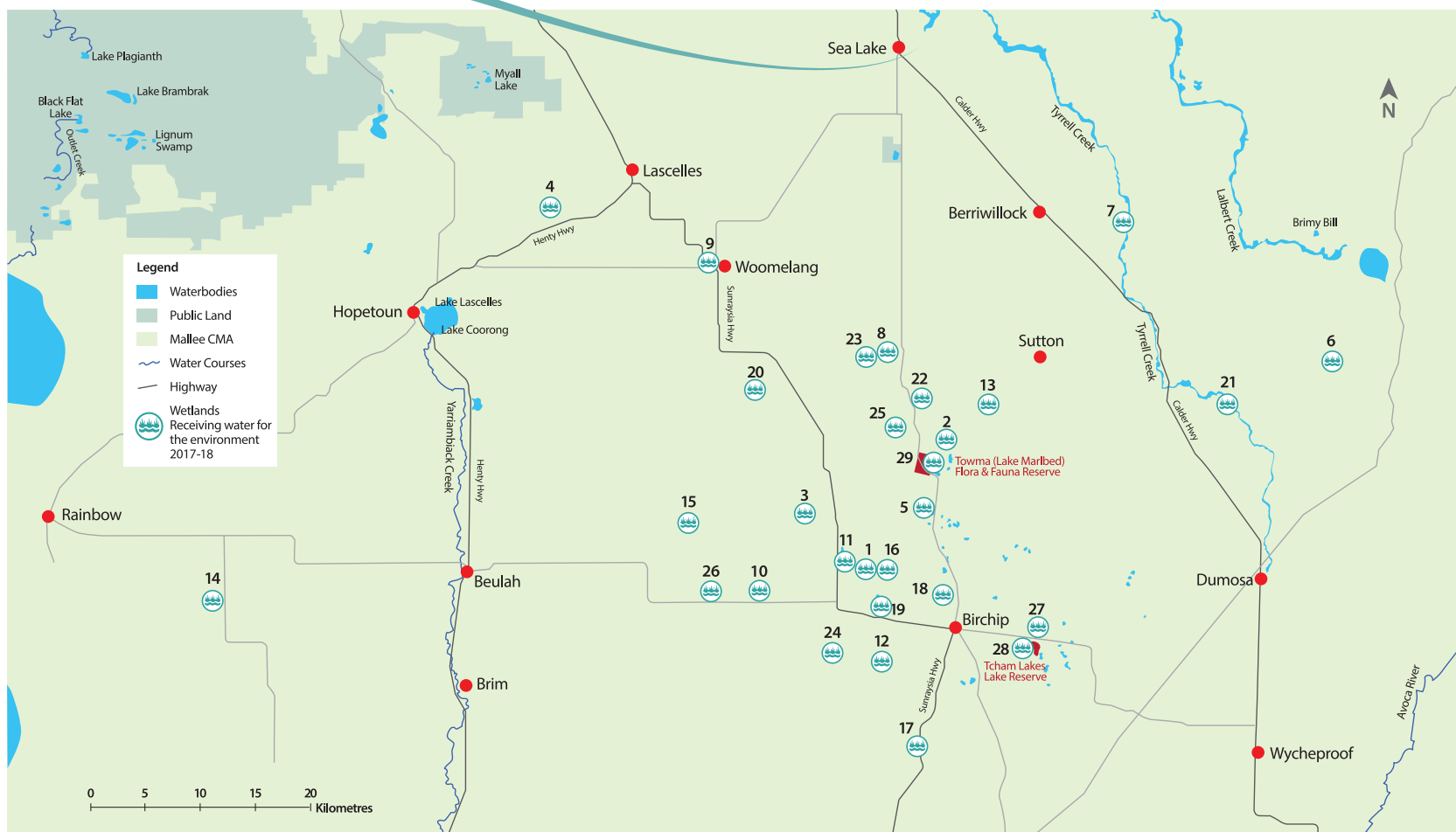


Water for Wimmera Mallee Wetlands 2017-18
