

Mallee Floodplain Management Strategy

Have your say on flood management in the Mallee.

A Floodplain Management Strategy has been developed for the Mallee region to provide a single, regional planning document and a 'rolling' three year works program to guide future investment priorities.

The Strategy interprets and applies the policies, actions and accountabilities outlined in the Victorian Floodplain Management Strategy.

The development of the Strategy has been guided by a steering committee, made up of representatives from local government, VicSES, water authorities and the Mallee CMA.

Key tasks undertaken in the development of the strategy have included:

- a period of public consultation on community identified risks
- a regional risk assessment
- Identification of existing flood mitigation strategies under the themes of land use planning and flood mitigation infrastructure
- Evaluation of flood risks through consideration of any existing service levels in place to mitigate flood risks, any gaps in service levels, and the priority for action.

The information gathered throughout the development of the strategy has been used to develop a regional works plan, which documents the regional priorities for the next three years, and associated responsibilities and timeframes.
