Working together on the Kings Billabong Regulator project

The Mallee Catchment Management Authority (CMA) has listened to the concerns of some members of the community and has made a decision to delay the construction of the Kings Billabong Regulator until the operating plan for this structure has been developed.

The operating plan will be developed in conjunction with the irrigation sector; Cooke Street residents; special interest groups such as the Friends of Kings Billabong; Indigenous stakeholders; and the wider community.

This process will ensure stakeholders understand and are comfortable with both the construction and operation of the Kings Billabong Regulator, prior to the structure being built. This course of action will also allow us to consolidate and present the science underpinning this project during this process.

We thank community members for their ongoing interest in Kings Billabong and look forward to working with you into the future.

More details on the development of the operating plan will be available in the near future.
